



HEATHER FARGO **Mayor of Sacramento**

- Mayor Heather Fargo was born in Oakland, CA and grew up in the Central Valley.
- She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Environmental Planning and Management from the University of California, Davis in 1975.
- First elected to the City Council in 1989, representing District One, she was re-elected to a second term in 1994, and a third term in 1998.
- She was elected to a four-year term as Mayor in November 2000.
- She became the City's first full-time Mayor in May of 2003 after passage of a Charter amendment. Mayor Fargo was re-elected in March 2004 to a second four-year term, which began in November 2004.
- Mayor Fargo currently serves as:
